NAWT's Berkshire Centre (also known as Trindledown Farm) provides a uniquely tranquil environment for elderly animals or animals that are finding it hard to cope in one of our other centres.

It can take longer to find homes for elderly dogs and cats, but at Trindledown Farm we are able to provide them with more spacious accommodation, complete with sofas and TVs to make their wait for that special home more comfortable.

Also some younger dogs find life in the busier kennels at our larger centres too stressful, so at our Berkshire Centre we are able to provide a quieter environment whilst they wait to be rehomed.





### **We care**

Staff and local volunteers work hard to provide the best care possible during an animal's stay with us. Our policy is to ensure the lifestyle of the prospective owner is appropriate to their choice of pet, so it is important to spend the time getting to know each individual animal's characteristics prior to rehoming.

### **Beautiful surroundings**

A whole host of other animals thrive in the centre's 10-acre surroundings. Horses, ponies, goats, alpacas, sheep and pigs graze in the Berkshire Downs whilst birds from cockatiels to quails flutter round our aviaries.

Elderly or stressed animals require special treatment, and our animal welfare team work hard to provide the best care possible. The staff understand the needs of our older residents, such as gentle exercise and special diets. The calm environment brings out the best in stressed dogs that were not coping at busier centres, and here at Trindledown Farm there is the space and time for training and play with the dedicated animal care team.



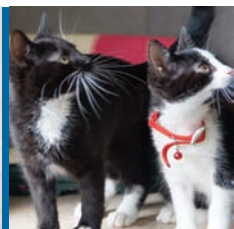


### **Fundraising events**
