We have put together this pack to give you the tools to make your fundraising successful.



How Your Fundraising Helps

£5 will feed a rabbit or cat for a week

£10 will buy warm bedding

£15 will microchip a homeless animal

£30 will feed a dog for a month

£50 will go towards an animal's veterinary treatment

£150 will vaccinate five homeless animals

JustGiving^{**}

Ask a grown up to help set you up a JustGiving page. JustGiving is a website where friends and family can donate to help you achieve your fundraising goal. All the money raised through the website will come directly to the NAWT, so you don't need to worry about following up with people to collect sponsorship money.







TIPS FOR JUSTGIVING

- 1. Use your JustGiving page to tell people why you are fundraising for the National Animal Welfare Trust.
- **2. Set a target** on your JustGiving page. Pages with a target raise more money.
- **3.** Use your JustGiving page to **share pictures and stories** about how your fundraising is going. Keep everyone up to date!
- **4.** Ask people you know who use **social media** to **share your JustGiving page online**.
- **5.** Thank people who donate to your page.



Design your own poster in the space below. You can include why and how you plan on fundraising for NAWT and don't forget to include details on where people can donate, such as your JustGiving page.




Donation Box Template

Cut out the donation box template to collect spare change at home. Print the page on card, or print it on paper and stick it to some cardboard that needs to be recycled. Cut around the edges and fold each side to form a cube. Cut the slot for the pennies. Glue along the edges and stick together.

We've included some digital graphics you can use to help promote your fundraising even further! Ask a parent/guardian or older sibling if they can share on their social media for you.






Or you can print them off and use as another poster to let people know you are fundraising for NAWT.
