



Classroom Activities

TEACHER NOTES:

The classroom activities are aimed at children who have been introduced to the work of rehoming centres and how they run. These activities can help reinforce what they have learnt after visiting one of our rehoming centres, or after staff have been in to give a presentation about rehoming work.

Poster

Print out information about one of our pets for rehoming from our website, www.nawt.org.uk/rehoming. Choose one with a range of pictures and lots of information.

On the class board, write down the basic information (age, name, breed, what sort of home they would be suitable for) and ask children to make a rehoming poster. They could draw the pet, or cut and paste pictures printed from our website. The rehoming poster could cover:

- ❃ Information about the pet
- ❃ What new owners need to think about before rehoming
- ❃ What new owners will need to purchase for their new pet
- ❃ A poem about the pet
- ❃ A poem about rehoming
