1	Can you provide proof of up to date vaccinations on arrival?	
	<b>Please note:</b> <i>we regret that pets will not be accepted on arrival if you do not bring proof of up-to-date vaccinations.</i>	
3	Will your pet have had preventative treatment for fleas and worms?	
4	Can you confirm that your pet does not suffer from epilepsy?	
	<b>Please note:</b> <i>We cannot accept pets who suffer from epilepsy.</i>	
5	Can you confirm your pet does not require diabetes injections?	
	<b>Please note:</b> <i>We cannot accept pets who require diabetes injections</i>	
6	Can you confirm that you do not expect us to feed a raw unprocessed meat diet?	
	<b>Please note:</b> <i>We cannot store or handle raw unprocessed meat so cannot accept any pets who require this diet.</i>	
7	Can you confirm that your animal is happy to be handled by staff?	
	<b>Please note:</b> <i>We cannot accept any animals that cannot be safely handled by our staff.</i>	
8	Can you confirm your female pet will not be in season when she arrives, or during her stay? (if relevant)	
	<b>Please note:</b> <i>We cannot accept a pet in season</i>	
9	Can you confirm your male cat is neutered if he is over 6 months? (if relevant)	
	<b>Please note:</b> <i>We cannot accept unneutered male cats over 6 months.</i>	
10	If boarding a dog and a cat, are you aware they cannot share a pen?	
	<b>Please note:</b> <i>Our facilities don't allow for dogs and a cats to share pens.</i>	
11	If your booking takes place during the school holidays, is it for a minimum of 7 days?	
	<b>Please note:</b> <i>We reserve the right to apply a minimum of 7 full days' boarding during school holidays.</i>
